- Only one adult should accompany your child/ren to school and should wear a face mask unless exempt, keeping at least 2m distance from other adults.
- Please do not accompany your child to school if you feel unwell or think you may have symptoms
 of Covid-19.
- A one way system will continue to be in place around the outside of the building to guide the children to their bubbles and this includes those using Breakfast Club.
- Each class will have a clearly labelled sign for the children to line up and to hand sanitise before entering their classroom.
- Once your child has been dropped off or picked up, please exit the site straight away.
- Please be patient, as all staff will continue to check whether there has been any illness in the
 family and whether the children have a coat, water bottle, snack, medication and packed lunch
 if needed.
- Children will continue to arrive in their PE kit on the day of their PE lesson.
- Please allow your child to bring only essential items to school.
