The new toddler group for children aged 0-5 will be held on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons 12.45 - 2.45 term time only.

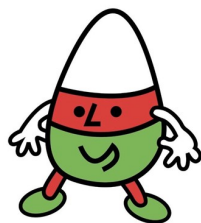
