IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Cases of Covid-19 in the local area seem to be on the rise. Very few cases have been reported in school amongst both pupils and staff. This is due to the care that is taken by our school community. Please continue to show respect for the protocols that are in place, in and around the school.

However, if the school is notified about a positive case of Covid-19 amongst the pupils, we will send out a 'Warn and Inform' letter that has been provided to us by the local authority. This letter provides advice about testing and isolating in case of any symptoms or a positive test.

Due to our strict systems in school, if a child in the junior classes tests positive, 'Warn and Inform' letters will only need to be sent to those pupils who sit directly either side while in class.

If a child in any of the Foundation Phase classes tests positive, a 'Warn and Inform' letter will be sent to the whole class as younger children have more difficulty in observing the socially distancing rules.

The current guidance is that unless a child tests positive or is showing symptoms they DO NOT NEED TO SELF-ISOLATE.

EXCITING PROJECT FOR YEARS 3/4

This term, Arts Connection Wales are working with pupils in Years 3 and 4 on a project called Adventures in Nature.

The project will cover four themes:

- 'Earth' sessions will focus on soil and plant biodiversity
- 'Water' sessions will focus on the biodiversity of the canal and rivers that run through Welshpool and look at how we reduce our water usage and take care not to pollute our waters
- 'Air' sessions will explore the importance of bugs and birds and how we can help them to thrive and their importance to our ecosystem
- 'Fire' sessions will explore trees and creating dens and fires safely while exploring the importance of trees for nesting birds and other animals
