Once again, please can we ask for considerate driving and parking in the school car park for the safety of all children, parents, staff and visitors? Also remember that there is NO SMOKING on Powys County Council property, including the school car park.

It is illegal to smoke in a car (or other vehicle) with anyone under 18. The law changed in 2015, to protect children and young people from the dangers of second-hand smoke.

Both the driver and the smoker could be fined £50. The law applies to every driver in England and Wales, including those aged 17 and those with a provisional driving licence.

SPARE CLOTHES

Occasionally, children need to be changed while in school due to accidents. We are finding that many items are not being returned to school when this happens. We politely request that if your child comes home in clothes borrowed from school, please could they be returned?
