#### YEARS 1 AND 2 SWIMMING LESSONS

We are extremely pleased to have been able to provide swimming lessons for all our children this year. Children in Year 1 and 2 will be the final year groups participating in swimming lessons on the following days this term:

Year 1 (Mrs Williams and Mrs Gittins-Evans): Tuesdays from 2.10pm Years 1 and 2 (Mrs Evans and Mrs Land): Wednesdays from 11.00am Years 1 and 2 (Miss Barnes): Fridays from 10.50am

The children will need to bring a swimming costume and towel in a bag, have a waterproof coat for the

walk to the pool and must have any medicines they need, such as an inhaler. Long hair must be worn in a ponytail or plaits and if you wish your child to wear googles, you must complete and return a form, which is available from the office before their first lesson.
