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### MONSTER PHONICS

Monster Phonics is a DfE validated phonics scheme that helps children to learn and recall spellings and our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes have been invited to trial it by the Welsh Government. Each letter/spelling sound is represented by a colour and a monster that makes that sound (a

sound cue). This brings phonics to life and makes Monster Phonics highly engaging. This is being funded by the Welsh Government for one year in the first instance and we are excited to announce that our resources have arrived, thanks to a generous donation from the Friends and match funding from the Monster Phonics team!
