The Pyjama Drama Clubs for younger pupils starts on Tuesday 20th September



throughout the school year to all pupils on a variety of subjects including safety at home, healthy relationships, stranger danger, substance misuse, online safety and as pupils reach Year 6 they will have sessions relating to the risks and dangers of sexual exploitation.

REMINDERS

Please can we remind all parents and carers that while we love to celebrate the children's birthdays, we are not able to share cakes and sweets in school. If your child would like to share a birthday cake with the class, please could these be sent in ready wrapped portions? Due to allergies and parental choice, cakes/sweets will be sent home to eat.

Please could we politely ask that your child does not wear necklaces to school as these can be dangerous if caught around the neck while playing. While studs are acceptable, dangling earrings can also cause health and safety issues during playtimes. We are also concerned about jewellery getting lost while on the school premises.
