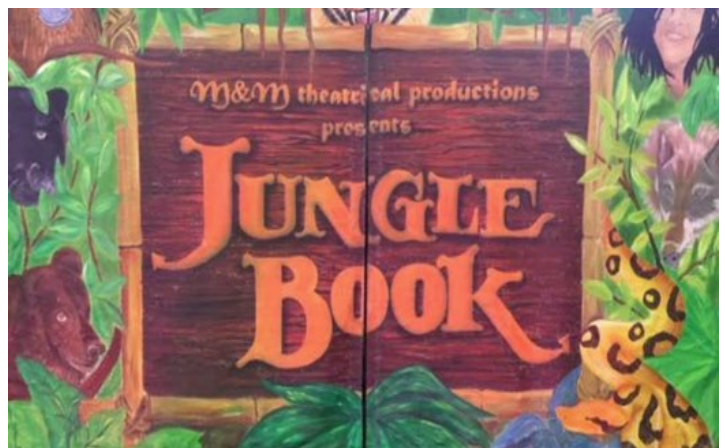
JUNGLE BOOK!

Please come along and join us. We look forward to seeing you there!



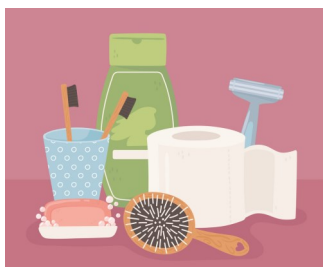
HYGIENE BANK
