The Primary and Junior School Admission Round for learners born between 01/09/2018 – 31/08/2019 opened on Monday 3 October 2022. Parents/Carers need to complete an online application at

Applying for a School Place



Primary Admissions

- Learners born between 01/09/18 - 31/08/19
- Opens on Monday, 3 October 2022
- Closing date for the admission round is Friday, 6 January 2023
- Children will start at the beginning of the Autumn Term AFTER the child has attained their 4th birthday.

Having a place at a nursery or pre-school class does not guarantee a place in the main school at age 4. You will still need to apply for a place in the main school. If you don't apply for a place, and your preferred school is full, preference will be given to those who have applied.

Please Note: Primary School Common offer date is Monday 17th April 2023.
