The autumn harvest is a time to remind ourselves about being thankful for what we already have.

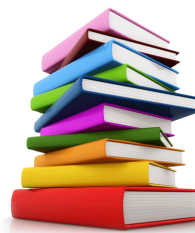


Often, collections of food are made for those in need.
