We are delighted to be organising two harvest services at St Mary's Church during the last week of this half term:

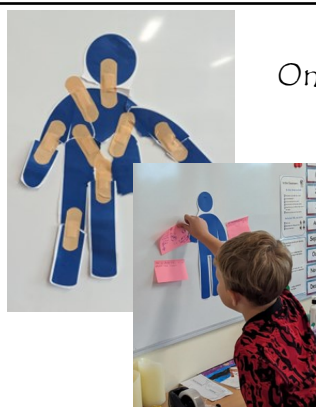
Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes on Monday 23rd October at 1.30pm
