TERM DATES AND INSET DAYS 2023—2024

Education in Wales is changing. From September 2023, all schools in Wales will be delivering the Curriculum for Wales.

Teachers and Teaching Assistants in schools and settings across Wales have been working very hard to design a new curriculum for our children. This includes working together as clusters of schools to plan for the progress a learner will make from the day they start school to the day they leave.

To support schools with this design process the Minister for Education, Jeremy Miles, has granted schools one additional INSET day every year for 2022–2023, 2023–2024 and 2024–2025. The table included in this letter outlines when these INSET days will take place for the 2023–2024 academic year. These INSET days are essential opportunities for schools to co-design a curriculum to support learner progression.
