	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sumdog</u> <u>Spelling and Grammar</u></p> <p>Use the link or use the Sumdog app on your device to complete the spelling and grammar activities set by your teacher.</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Roald Dahl Day</u></p> <p>It is Roald Dahl Day on 13th September. Read one of his books or watch a film version. Complete either a book or film review. Include a title, main characters, a summary of the plot – don't give the ending away! Include whether you enjoyed it and say why.</p>
	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sumdog</u> <u>Maths</u></p> <p>Use the link or use the Sumdog app on your device to complete the spelling and grammar activities set by your teacher.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Terrific Times Tables!</u></p>  <p>Choose a times table (you could choose more than one!) and make an information poster to support your learning. You could draw pictures, make up a rhyme or song and use bright colours!</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Wild Animals!</u></p>  <p>Research and create an information poster on your favourite animal. Within your poster identify: The group which the animal belongs to. Where the animal lives. What the animal likes to eat. The features that the animal has to help it survive.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The Digital World</u></p> <p>Many would argue that today, we cannot get by without laptops, computers, or tablets. But where did it all begin? Use the internet to research and create a timeline to show where digital technology began, to where it is today. Remember to include key dates and pictures!</p> 
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Money, Money, Money!</u></p>  <p>Using the internet or the library, find out about and research the different currencies around the world. Which is the most interesting? Are there any countries that do not use paper money? Which currency is the oldest?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Half the World Away!</u></p> <p>There are lots of countries all around the world – all with their own cultures, traditions, and ways of life. Choose a country to make an information poster about. Include things that are important to the country such as: national days, traditions, national food, and culture.</p> 
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE with Joe!</u></p>  <p>Head to the "PE with Joe" YouTube channel and choose a workout to complete. Could you create your own workout and create your own video to share with your class?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ValYOU!</u></p>  <p>Everybody has things which they value and are important to you. Draw the outline of our head and shoulders, or entire body. Once complete, fill your body with things that are important to you. If you value it, or if it is important to you, add it to your creation!</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Still Life Drawings</u></p>  <p>Look at the painting 'Still Life with Pitcher and Apples' by Pablo Picasso. It was created by arranging objects onto a tabletop. Find 3 or 4 items from your home which you value and arrange them on a tabletop. Using a pencil, paints, or crayons, recreate Pablo Picasso's artwork.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Inside Out!</u></p>  <p>Watch the video "Inside Out: Guessing the feelings." on YouTube. What makes the girl feel the various emotions? Create a story map of the video but change the scenarios to suit your own emotions. What could happen to make you happy, sad, angry, and upset? Talk with somebody at home the ways in which these emotions could be handled.</p>
