	<p><b>Sumdog Grammar &amp; Spelling</b></p> <p>Complete the tasks set by your teacher. Click on the heading above to take you straight to Sumdog!</p> 	<p><b>The Twits - Play!</b></p> <p>We all enjoyed reading The Twits but did you know the book has also been turned into a play? Google Classroom has sections of the playscript to look at and in school we'll be doing more with them!</p>
	<p><b>Sumdog Maths</b></p> <p>Complete the task set by your teacher. Click on the heading above to take you straight to Sumdog!</p> 	<p><b>Maths Concept</b></p> <p>Use the activity sheet on Google Classroom to represent various maths concepts in different ways.</p>
	<p><b>Watch the Birdy!</b></p> <p>Last week you made a bird feeder. This week we want you to identify the birds visiting your feeder. Go to Google Classroom to find spotter guides and an activity to try.</p>	<p><b>Scratch/Coding</b></p> <p>Using Scratch on J2e, follow the instructions to create a game. You can send a link of your game to your class teacher for them to try it out. You'll find further information in Google Classrooms.</p>
	<p><b>Olympic Countries</b></p> <p>Use a Top Trump template to create some Top Trump cards based on countries who enter the Olympic games. Take a look at Google Classrooms for examples of data you could include!</p>	<p><b>We're going to the zoo, zoo, zoo!</b></p> <p>Design a word-search using a variety of animal names you have learnt over the weeks when visiting the virtual zoo. Ask somebody at home to complete the word-search. Use a stopwatch to see how long it takes them.</p>
	<p><b>Skills Challenge!</b></p> <p>Take a look in your Google Classroom folder for this week's Premier League Challenge!</p>	<p><b>Read a story!</b></p> <p>You have spent many weeks listening to the Year 3 and 4 teachers read The Twits story to you. Now it is your turn to read your favourite story to somebody in your family or a pet.</p> 
	<p><b>Number Ones</b></p> <p>Ask members of your family which year they were born in. Then research which songs were number one in this year. Ask your relatives which number one was their favourite. Have a go at learning their favourites by singing along together.</p> 	<p><b>DIY Medal!</b></p> <p>Last week you took part in the 'Just a Minute' challenges. This week your job is to design a medal for one of the 'Just a Minute' challenges that could be given to somebody who managed to beat the world record. <b>(See Google Classroom for full details)</b></p>
