Wednesday	Listen to Chapter 9 of The Explorer and complete the activity on Google Classroom.	Complete the work on Google Classroom.	Have a go at drawing or painting your favourite polar animal.
Thursday	Look through the Welsh power points on Google Classroom. Can you say where your friend lives and in which type of home? Can you say why your friend likes living where they do? Practise the new phrases you have learnt. Maybe you could write some sentences or even record yourself!	Use the BBC Weather website to find the temperatures for today in the North Pole. 1) What is the coldest temperature today? What time is this? 2) What is the warmest temperature today? What time is this? 3) What is the difference between these temperatures. Search two other cold places in the world, repeat the above questions for these places.	Write a letter to the Prime Minister to explain what effect climate change is having on the Polar regions.
