



# What we'll be doing this half-term

This half term, we will be continuing with our topic of "Energy". We will be learning about safety around electricity and creating electrical circuits before moving onto learning about the Olympic Games in preparation for Paris 2024.

In Science and Technology, as part of our topic the children will learn the effects that food and exercise have on themselves and how this can affect their energy levels.

In our Maths lessons, we will be learning how to find the perimeter and area of different shapes. We will then go onto measuring different types of angles. We will also be learning about types of average such as mode, median, range and mean.

In our English lessons, we will begin by focusing on story writing, role play and letter writing. In our Welsh lessons, we will be learning all about Wales, including looking at famous physical and human geographical features. We will then move onto reviewing a book and the children will go onto discussing their favourite books through the medium of Welsh.

In RVE we will be continuing with our Young Leader Award focusing on community action.

# <u> PE</u>

Your child will have two sessions of PE per week, and it is important they come to school wearing appropriate sports clothing such as black shorts, a white t-shirt and trainers. They should also wear dark tracksuit bottoms/joggers and a jumper or hoody when it is colder.
